The 1999 is another in a long line of “Industrial Strength” Pahlmeyer Chardonnays. Mouth filling, powerful and rich, this wine has a crisp backbone of minerals and integrated acid surrounding a ripe fruit core.

Winemaking Notes:

Harvested from October 4 to 9, 1999 at 25.3 brix, the grapes were barrel-fermented with wild yeasts and aged in 100% new Francois Freres French oak barrels for 14 months with full malolactic fermentation.
