## **Pahlmeyer 2001 Napa Valley Chardonnay**

### **Tasting Notes:**

The Napa Valley Chardonnay is classically styled, with aromas of tropical fruit combining with citrus nuances that integrate fully with hints of creamy oak. The palate is sleek and balanced with mineral and citrus flavors and a finish that is long and lingering.

### **Winemaker's Notes:**

Harvested at 24.9 brix, the grapes were barrel-fermented on wild yeasts and aged in 100% new François Frères French oak barrels for 11 months. The wine also progressed through 100% malolactic fermentation on wild yeasts. The wine was bottled neither filtered nor fined.
