Tasting Notes:

The Sonoma Coast Chardonnay carries with it the quintessential characteristics of the Russian River appellation. The nose lavishes you with aromas of orange blossom, citrus and hints of caramel. The nose follows through on the palate and finishes long and full-bodied.

Winemakers Notes:

Harvested at 25.8 brix, the grapes were barrel-fermented on wild yeasts and aged in 100% new François Freres French oak barrels for 11 months. The wine also progressed through 100% malolactic fermentation on the wild yeasts. The wine was bottled neither filtered nor fined.
