### TASTING NOTES

The 2003 Jayson Chardonnay is sure to be a hit with our "Jayson Fan Club". The 2003 Jayson exhibits robust aromas of vanilla, cream and butter. The mouth feel is counterbalanced by both ample acidity and lush viscosity.

### WINEMAKER NOTES

The Jayson Chardonnay is a "declassification" of the "Industrial Strength" Pahlmeyer Chardonnay. After a meticulous selection process in assembling the final blend of our Pahlmeyer Chardonnay, we felt that the quality of the remaining lots of wine were of a class that deserved the "Jayson" label. The 2003 Jayson Chardonnay was hand crafted with the same care and attention that is given to all of our wines. It is an excellent value at a portion of the price of the Pahlmeyer Chardonnay (to be released Spring 2005).
