### VINTAGE NOTES

In 2017, significant rainfall in the spring led into a normal budbreak period in late March with bloom occurring mid-May. The vineyard encountered multiple heat spikes throughout the summer creating a dry environment in which the grapevines matured and developed concentrated flavors.

### WINEMAKING NOTES

Grape clusters were hand-picked in the cool of the night, then hand-sorted at the winery. We gently de-stemmed the grapes using only whole, intact berries for fermentation. After extended cold soak, the grapes entered fermentation for 14 to 19 days, then the free-run wine was drained to French oak barrels where the wine aged for 9 months.

### TASTING NOTES

This wine has deep ruby red color in the glass. Aromas of cherry blossom and sweet, dark blueberries lead onto a dense, creamy palate with flavors of ripe black fruit and seductive oak. This is a fruit-driven, hedonistic, approachable Pinot Noir.
